The allied associations for golf in the state of Florida, through our Golf Florida Alliance, have been communicating with the Governor's office and state leaders in an effort to obtain further clarification on the single/shared rider policy for golf carts.

We are excited to have received clarification from the Governor's office that golf carts can be shared by family members or significant others residing in the same household. Please note all other carts shall be single rider only. This is in effect immediately (Saturday, April 25th).

Please note these guidelines would not supersede local or county orders which may be more stringent on this policy. We ask that you continue to enforce strict social distancing and properly apply this new cart policy so we can keep safety in our game and continue to enjoy this privilege.

We appreciate the guidance and assistance from the Governor and his team during these challenging times and will continue to communicate any state orders or changes to this policy as they become available.
