Dear Allied Association Members,

The Golf Florida Alliance has received written clarification from Secretary Halsey Beshears of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) with respect to shared golf cars. DBPR is the enforcement agency for the state Executive Orders pertaining to Covid 19.

Secretary Beshears indicated in writing that Executive Order 20-139 allows all sporting events in Florida to happen at capacity and this applies to golf courses (including the use of golf carts), tennis courts, and outdoor events. Specific to golf carts we would refer you to the Back2Golf guidelines version 4.0 that allows shared golf carts with some guidance . [CLICK HERE](#) for a full copy of the Back2Golf Operations Playbook, which gives specific guidelines on the use of cart operations.

Please note there could be local county orders in place that provide direct guidelines for all golf related activities including the use of golf carts. In the absence of local county orders we would encourage you to rely on the Back2Golf playbook to guide your decisions.

Secretary Beshears also encouraged all Floridians to avoid congregating in groups larger than 50 persons and encouraged senior citizens with underlying medical conditions to avoid crowds.
